LPR Technology Comes to TCNJ!

Our new and improved electronic permitting system along with License Plate Recognition (LPR) eliminates the need for a physical permit. No more worrying about properly displaying your parking permit or picking up new permits for replacement vehicles. You will not receive a parking decal or placard this year. This latest technology will allow your license plate to be your parking permit!

When a vehicle is parked on campus, the license plate is read by LPR readers mounted on a designated campus police vehicle or by a handheld reader operated by Campus Police. LPR works like a supermarket scanner with your license plate functioning as the barcode. When read, the numbers of your plate are automatically referenced against the parking database to verify proper parking privileges for the parking location. **You are still required to follow all of our parking rules and regulations at all times to avoid being ticketed.**

All motorists must now park with your license plate facing the drive lane. Because LPR technology only works if a license plate can be read by the LPR readers, it is imperative that your license plate always face the drive lane. If your state does not issue a front plate, you cannot back into a parking space. You are subject to being ticketed if your vehicle is parked without the license plate facing the drive lane of traffic.

- Aquatics members are instructed to park in lot 12 (behind Packer Hall). To enable you to enter this gated lot, the appropriate access has been added to the enclosed Guest ID card.
- Your virtual parking permit is non-transferrable and is only valid for the license plate you provided to us. If you get a new vehicle or license plate, please make sure to update the information with Parking Services or you may be ticketed.
- Unless otherwise noted, your virtual parking permit will expire on 8/31/26. In order to renew your virtual parking permit, you will need to contact your TCNJ liaison.
- The "visitor/vendor" parking spaces on the street outside of the pool parking lot are only for people with a valid visitor parking permit – the virtual parking permit you have been issued only allows you to park within parking lot 12.

- If you have a swipe card and it is not working, please park in lots 5, 6, or 7. You should contact Parking Services about this issue at parking@tcnj.edu or call (609)771-3144 or 2172. You will need to provide us with the last 5 digits of the 16 digit ISO number on the front of the swipe card. The access on your swipe card will be turned off when your parking permit expires.
- Please do not lose or dispose of your swipe card! There will be a \$20.00 replacement fee for any lost swipe card.
- If you receive a parking ticket on TCNJ's campus, it will need to be paid. If you feel it was issued in error, you may appeal within fifteen (15) days of ticket issuance. Citation appeals must be completed online at: <http://parking.tcnj.edu/violations-fines/citation-appeals/>.
